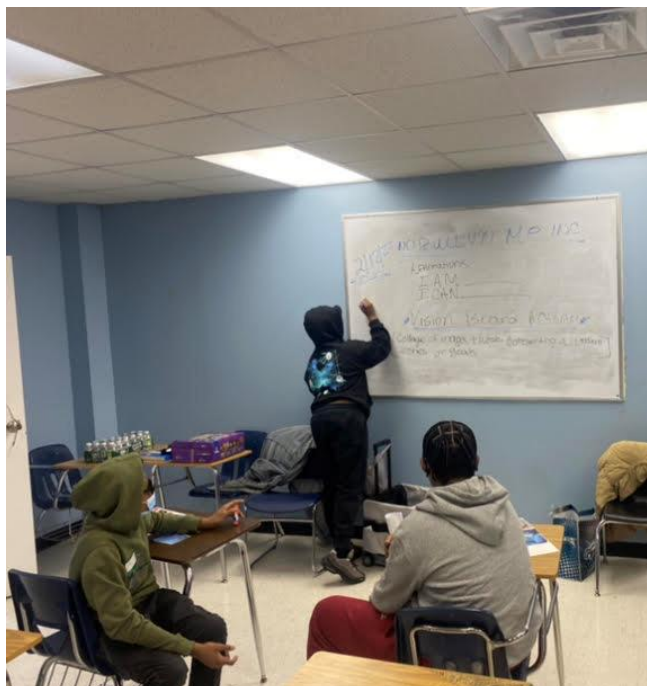
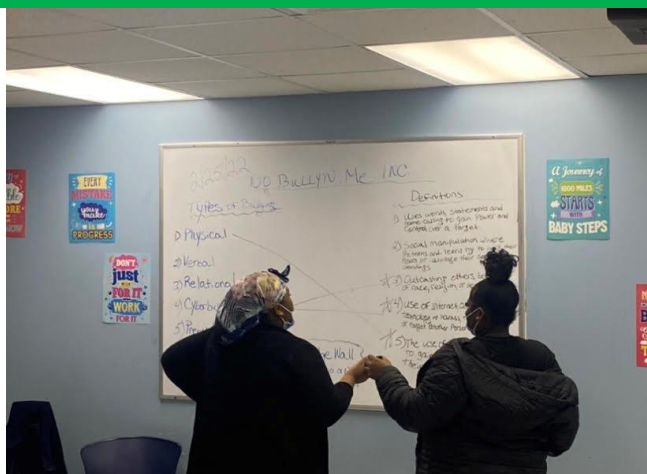


What's happening at NBMI?
